Rules for Internet and Computer Use

- Patrons must sign in at the circulation desk. Computers sessions are limited to 60 minutes per day.
- Printing items are black and white only with a .25 charge per page.
- Computers are shut down 5 minutes before closing.
- Frothingham Free Library provides public access to the internet in keeping with the role as a source of information, intellectual development and enrichment for the community.
- Frothingham Free Library has no control over this research tool and assumes no responsibility for the content, quality, accuracy or currency of the information retrieved.
- Use of this access for any illegal or criminal purpose is prohibited. Pornography or any sexually explicit sites are forbidden.
- It should be understood the Library cannot act as censor or substitute parent. It is the responsibility of the parents or legal guardian to provide guidance to ensure their ward uses the internet in an appropriate or safe manner.
